**Equestrian Canada  
Statement of Principles**

Equestrian Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to the humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction. All persons shall be committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of all horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and compassion, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
- Ensuring that all Equestrians including owners, trainers and competitors, or their respective agents, use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their own horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure;
- Providing current information on Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines and other equine health and welfare initiatives;
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- Requiring owners, trainers and competitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions; and
- Actively promoting the development of and adherence to competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horse.

The Standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person who is informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and competition procedures would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

**PERSON RESPONSIBLE**

The Person Responsible (PR) for a horse must be an adult who has, or shares responsibility for the care, training, custody, and performance of the horse and who has official responsibility for that horse under EC or USEF Rules. The PR is liable under the penalty provisions of the applicable EC or USEF Rules for any rule violations. The Person Responsible is ultimately responsible for the condition, fitness and management of the horse and is alone responsible for any act performed by himself/herself or by any other person with authorized access to the horse in the stables, elsewhere on the grounds, or while the horse is being ridden, driven or exercised. [The Person Responsible must hold a valid EC Sport License in good standing at the same level or higher in which the horse is competing. However, when the competitor is a junior, the competitor cannot be the Person Responsible and the Person Responsible may be the trainer, the owner of the horse, or a parent/guardian who must be at minimum an EC or USEF member in good standing.]

### Location and Show Office

The Ottawa Dressage Festival is held at the Wesley Clover Parks (WCP), 401 Corkstown Road, Ottawa, Ontario, K2H 7T8. Wesley Clover Parks is easily accessible from Highways 417 and 416. Telephone: (613) 304-4933. The show office is located close to the stabling area and is indicated by a sign.

### Parking

Parking for competitors will be near the stabling area and will be clearly identified. The parking is about 1 km down Corkstown Road from Moodie Dr., on the right hand side. **Vehicles must be parked in designate areas.**

### Directions

#### Highway 417 Eastbound & Westbound

1. Take Moodie Drive Exit and go Northbound on Moodie Drive
2. At the first set of lights, turn left onto Corkstown Road and follow to Wesley Clover Parks

#### Highway 416 Northbound

1. North on Hwy 416 to Moodie Dr. N exit 75C
2. Follow signs for Chemin Acres Road/Chemin Richmond Rd.
3. Use the left lane to turn left onto Holly Acres Rd/Ottawa Regional Rd 16 W
4. Turn left to merge onto Trans-Canada Hwy/ON-417 W toward Promenade Moodie Drive
5. Use the right lane to take Moodie Drive N and go over Hwy 417
4. After lights Left on Corkstown Road and follow to Wesley Clover Parks

## General Rules and Regulations

The **Ottawa Dressage Festival** competition is sanctioned as a Platinum and Gold competition member of Equestrian Canada, 308 Legget Drive, Ottawa, Ontario, K2K 1Y6 and is governed by the rules of Equestrian Canada (Art. A602.1) and the FEI rules.

“Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book.” (Art. A602.2)

“All Canadian entries are required to hold an EC Horse Recording and have paid the EC Horse Recording annual Activation Fee to compete, or if owned by a temporary sport license holder, a *Temporary Horse Registration* form must be purchased at each competition entered. Foreign entries must sign an affidavit.” (Art. A602.4)

“Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location.” (Art. A602.5)

“Per A801, every entry at an EC-sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC-sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition. Do not participate in this EC-sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition.” (Art. A602.7)

The CDI3\*/CDI1\*/CDIJ/CDIY/CDIU25 event is organized in accordance with the most recent versions of the FEI Statutes, FEI General Regulations, FEI Dressage Regulations, FEI Veterinary Regulations, the Rules for Dressage Events, Equine Anti-Doping and Controlled Medication Regulations, FEI Anti-Doping Rules for Human Athletes and any other relevant FEI regulations. All FEI rules and regulations will be strictly enforced. It is the responsibility of NFs to ensure their participants are of the correct age.

## The FEI Code of Conduct

The FEI requires all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount. Welfare of the horse must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

## Show Office Hours

The show office will be open from 11:00 to 18:00 on Wednesday, May 17<sup>th</sup>. On show days, Thursday, May 18<sup>th</sup> through Sunday, May 21<sup>st</sup>, the show office will open one hour prior to competition each morning and close one hour after competition ends. Emergency numbers will be posted on the show office door when the show office is closed.

## Insurance

All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They must take out third party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and keep the policy up to date.

## Entries & Inquiries

All CDI and Gold entries must be received by end of day **Thursday May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017**. No entries are accepted by telephone or fax. Online entries are accepted at [www.equestrianentries.com](http://www.equestrianentries.com). Late entries will be accommodated where possible with an additional charge of \$70 per CDI entry and \$50 per Gold entry. A change fee of \$35/class will apply during the show. Payments may be made by cheque or Interac. When using Interac, email payment to [odf@nationalcapitaldressage.ca](mailto:odf@nationalcapitaldressage.ca) with a separate email containing a password. Your entry will only be accepted if it includes:

- Completed entry form with proper signatures and stabling information (if applicable).
- Payment in full. No postdated cheques. \$70 charge for NSF cheques. **Please note that an interest rate of 5% per year (or any part thereof) will apply for any payment not received within 30 days of the completion of the show.**
- Proof of horse liability and insurance coverage. Note: OEF membership card is sufficient.
- Photocopies of negative Coggins or other EIA test within 12 months of competition date.

- For foreign-owned horses, a signed affidavit certifying the horse's eligibility and the owner, rider/driver and trainer are members in good standing of their own national federation. (EC General Rules Art. A404.2)

### **IMPORTANT: CDI Entries**

**AUTHORIZATION TO COMPETE:** All CDI riders must request that an authorization to compete is sent to the OC by their NF. No rider/horse combination will be accepted without this written authorization. All entries must be submitted **through the FEI's Online Entry System. Canadian athletes will be entered through the FEI Online Entry System by the OC of the Ottawa Dressage Festival; athletes from other nations by their respective NF.** Athletes and/or horses present at the event that have not been entered through the FEI's Online Entry System will automatically be disqualified. Deadline for definite entries is May 4, 2017. Last date for substitutions is 2 hours prior to horse inspection on May 18, 2017.

### **Class Limitations**

Show management reserves the right to refuse any entry, cancel, postpone, change, or reschedule any class they deem advisable. **Hors Concours entries are not accepted.**

### **Non-Competing Horses**

The owner of a non-competing horse must:

- Complete and sign an entry form;
- Provide a valid negative Coggins test (within last 12 months);
- Provide proof of Influenza vaccination & booster if stabling in the FEI stable;
- Pay a fee of \$120 per horse plus stabling (optional), administration and drug fees;
- Ensure the horse wears its assigned number at all times and complies with all EC and competition rules.

### **Refunds/Scratches**

Entry fees will be refunded (less \$50 administration fee) if canceled in writing before the closing date of **Thursday, May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017**. Otherwise no fees will be refunded. Stabling fees will not be refunded after the closing date. Freestyle class fees will be refunded for non-qualifying horses.

### **Stabling and Arrival/Departure**

Portable stalls will be available for a fee of \$190 plus HST from noon Wednesday May 17 until Sunday, May 21. This fee applies to each stall, whether for stabling or a tack stall. Priority for stalls will be given to competing horses. ALL stalls must be vacated by 7:00 pm Sunday, May 21 unless arrangements are made with the show secretary. For those wishing to arrive in advance of May 17 or stay after May 21, additional days can be arranged at \$20/night. Horses arriving in advance or remaining after May 21 will be required to share the cost of overnight security.

**ALL CDI horses MUST be stabled on grounds. EC national horses wishing to stable with the CDI horses (space permitting) MUST have proof of flu vaccinations as per FEI rules and ID documentation.**

Shavings are not included but can be purchased in advance for \$8 per bag, plus HST. There will be additional shavings available for purchase during the show.

Stalls may be available for rent for the day at \$100/day plus HST. These stalls will be available at 6:00 am in the morning and must be vacated and cleaned by 7:00 pm of the same day. Day stalls will be in a separate barn without electricity.

Please include stabling information and fees with your entry.

**Riding Times** will be available by end of day Sunday, May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017 on [www.nationalcapitaldressage.ca](http://www.nationalcapitaldressage.ca) and on [Foxvilage.com](http://Foxvilage.com). Show Management reserves the right to change times as deemed necessary. **Please check the day sheets posted in the office and stabling area each day before competitions begin.**

### **CDI Draw**

Thursday, May 18<sup>th</sup>: ½ hour after the horse inspection. Friday, May 19<sup>th</sup>: ½ hour after the last competition. Saturday, May 20<sup>th</sup>: ½ hour after the last competition. Draws will be conducted as an ordinary draw (FEI Art. 425.2) for all classes except the Grand Prix (will follow FEI Art. 425.2.1.b), Grand Prix Special (will follow FEI Art. 425.4) and all CDI freestyle classes (will follow FEI Art. 425.5).

### **Exercise Schedule**

Competitors must only use the designated warm-up areas. All competition rings will be open for practice from 13:00 to 17:00 pm Wednesday, May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017. If time permits there will be open schooling in the competition rings after classes during the show. Please check the show office for information posted about additional access to competition rings during the show.

Schooling will be allowed in the CDI ring ONLY for horses with classes scheduled in that ring; 11:00 to 18:00 on Wednesday, May 17<sup>th</sup> and from 8:00 to 19:30 on Thursday, May 18<sup>th</sup>.

Lungeing (un-mounted) and work in hand may only take place in the designated lungeing area. (See EC Dressage rules on lungeing.)

### **Other Show Information**

- Contact show secretary for electrical hookups for trailers.
- Properly fastened protective headgear is mandatory at all times when mounted (Art. E 4.0).
- Horses must always wear their competition (or ID) number when outside their stall.
- Horses may only be bathed in the designated wash stalls.
- Food and beverages are sold on site by a variety of vendors.



- Dogs or other pets must be on a leash at all times.
- All motorized vehicles, including golf carts, must be operated by a licensed driver.

### **Class and Prize Information**

**Classes:** Juniors and Amateurs may also enter Open classes in order to be eligible for awards in both categories. A class fee will have to be paid for entering in two categories of the same class, e.g. Training Test 1 Jr and Training Test 1 Open.

For equitation classes, a rider entering training level equitation cannot be entered in a first level class.

**Freestyles:** In the EC Freestyle Test of Choice class, riders may choose to ride any EC freestyle. In the FEI Freestyle Test of Choice class, riders may choose to ride any FEI freestyle, except the Para FEI freestyle tests. Riders wishing to ride a Para Freestyle must enter the FEI Para Freestyle Test of Choice class. Two functioning copies of music CDs for freestyles must be submitted to the Show Secretary prior to or at the sound check. CDs must be labelled with the competitor's name, horse's name, class # and any instructions. Times for sound checks will be posted in the show office.

**Test of Choice classes:** Riders may choose to ride any technical test at the level designated by the class. Exception: riders may not ride a Young Horse test in the FEI Test of Choice class.

**Prizes:** Ribbons will be awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place in all classes. See the class list at the end of this document for details.

**Grand Prix Freestyle perpetual trophy** is awarded to the winning horse/rider combination in the CDI Grand Prix Freestyle class. A keepsake plaque is awarded to the rider.

**Leading Athlete Award (CDI)** is awarded to the horse/rider combination with the highest total score of any 2 tests. **The winner will receive a custom saddle (value of \$6,800) from County Saddlery Inc.**

**High score for FEI Test of Choice:** a ribbon and/or a prize will be given to the horse/rider combination with the highest score over the entire show in an FEI Test of Choice class.

**High score for Youth (under 18):** A ribbon and/or a prize will be given to the horse/rider combination with the highest score over the entire Gold Show.

**Sue Rothgeb Award:** A ribbon and a prize will be awarded to the adult amateur second level high score in memory of Sue Rothgeb, one of the builders of the sport of dressage in Canada and long-time supporter of the Ottawa Dressage Festival.

ODF2017 has dedicated the CDI Junior Division to the memory of Diana Dillingham, long time steward at ODF who suddenly passed away in April 2017.

Ribbons and prizes may be picked up from the Awards and Prizes booth located in the show office. Please note: For the purposes of championships, prize money and class ribbons, show management reserves the right to hold only an open category if there are fewer than six entries per category (Art. E7.2.2).

**Championships** will be determined by adding the scores from Test 1, Test 2, and Test 3 in the specific *EC division/level*. In all *Gold FEI divisions*, championships will be determined by adding the scores from the two technical tests. Exception: Championship for the Children’s Division will be determined by adding the scores from all three tests. **Please note that scores from the “Test of Choice” classes will not count towards any Championship.** Exception: *Para championship* will be determined based on the two highest scores, excluding freestyles, from the para test of choice classes. In the event of a tie, the rider with the highest single percentage score is declared the winner (Art. E 9.10.5).

### **Awards Presentation**

“Participation in the prize-giving ceremony of placed Athlete/Horse combinations is compulsory. Failure to do so entails losing the classification (rosette, plaque, prize in kind, prize money).” As per FEI Art. A436, competitors are required to be mounted for all CDI class awards. Riders are requested to ride the horse on which they have won the award being presented. Anyone wishing to substitute a horse (for safety reasons) for presentations, must first inform and be given approval by the President of the Ground Jury and the OC through the FEI steward and secretary. **Efforts will be made to hold mounted presentations immediately following completion of CDI classes. Please check notices posted in the Show Office for timing of mounted presentations.**

Gold championship ribbons, prizes and tests can be collected at in the Awards and Prizes desk. Championship awards will be given on Sunday.

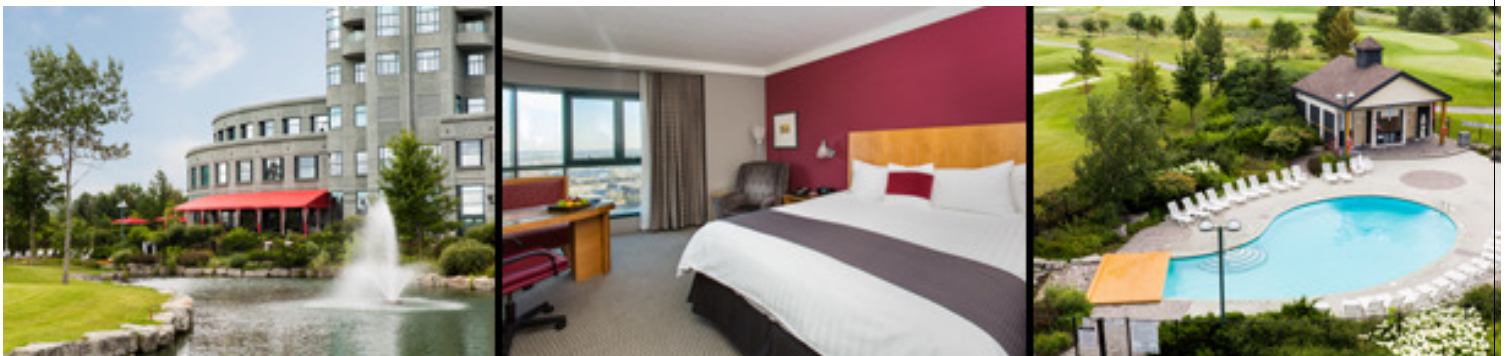
