***Person Responsible** for a horse must be an adult who has, or shares, responsibility for the care, training, custody, and performance of the horse and who has official responsibility for that horse under EC Rules and is liable under the penalty provisions of the Rules for any violation of the EC Rules. For the purpose of these Rules, the PR is normally the trainer, owner or the competitor who rides or drives the horse during an event, or a parent or legal guardian in the case of junior (legal minor) competitors. The PR is ultimately responsible for the condition, fitness and management of the horse and is alone responsible for any act preformed in the stables by themselves or by any other person with authorized access to the horse, or while the horse is being ridden, driven or exercised. The PR must hold a valid EC Sport License in good standing at the same level or higher in which the horse is competing. Junior (legal minor) competitors cannot be the PR. In the case of Junior (legal minor) owner entries the PR may be a parent/guardian **OR** EC Sport License holder of age of majority.

Parents/guardians for competitors under the age of 18 years are not required to have an EC Sport Licence provided they agree to abide by the rules and penalties contained in the Rule Book and acknowledge that they are liable under the penalty provisions of the Rules for any violations of the EC Rules by their minor child.

A. Release from liability while on premises

The undersigned acknowledge(s) that there are risks inherent in all horse related activities, which could result in serious physical harm or death to horse, rider, groom, assistant, spectator and others. Such activities could also result in damage to or loss of property. The undersigned agree(s) to assume these risks and all associated legal risks while at Wesley Clover Parks (the “premises”) during the days of the competition to which this entry relates. Furthermore, the undersigned agree(s) to:

- Hold harmless and indemnify Equestrian Canada (EC), National Capital Dressage Inc., Wesley Clover Parks, and all their officials, officers, directors, employees, volunteers, agents, and representatives, and;
- Release them from any liability or responsibility for accident, damage, injury, death, or illness to the undersigned, any horse which the undersigned cause(s) to be on the premises, or any family member or spectator accompanying the undersigned on the premises or attending at the premises for the purposes of visiting or viewing the undersigned, and from liability for loss of, theft of, or damage to any property belonging to any of these individuals, howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the undersigned taking part in the aforesaid competition and not withstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the said bodies, or any of them, and all of their officials, directors, employees, volunteers, agents, and representatives.

B. Agreement to be bound by rules and regulations

Per Article A801, every entry at an EC sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the Person Responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition. Do not participate in this EC sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition. The Person Responsible agrees to the release of any information on the entry form to EC. Every entry shall further constitute an undertaking that to accept as final the decision of the EC Board of Directors on any question arising under said rules.

- I hereby certify that every horse, rider and/or driver is eligible as entered and agree for myself and my representatives to be bound by the Constitution and rules of EC at this competition. It is hereby recognized that all equestrian sports involve inherent risk and that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury. I hereby accept this risk and hold harmless EC, the competition, their officials, organizers, agents, employees and their representatives. The person(s) responsible (PR) agrees to the release of any information on the entry form to EC. (A802.4)
- I hereby certify that every horse listed on this entry form has met the requirements of Article A519, Vaccinations. See Rules of EC, Section A, General Regulations, Article A519, Vaccinations. (A802.7)
- Further for junior riders: In the event that _____ participates in an EC sanctioned competition where protective headgear is required for juniors, they will wear properly fitted and fastened approved headgear at all times while riding or driving at the event location. It is understood that juniors not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete at these competitions. See Rules of EC, Section A, General Regulations, Article A905, Headgear. (A802.6)
